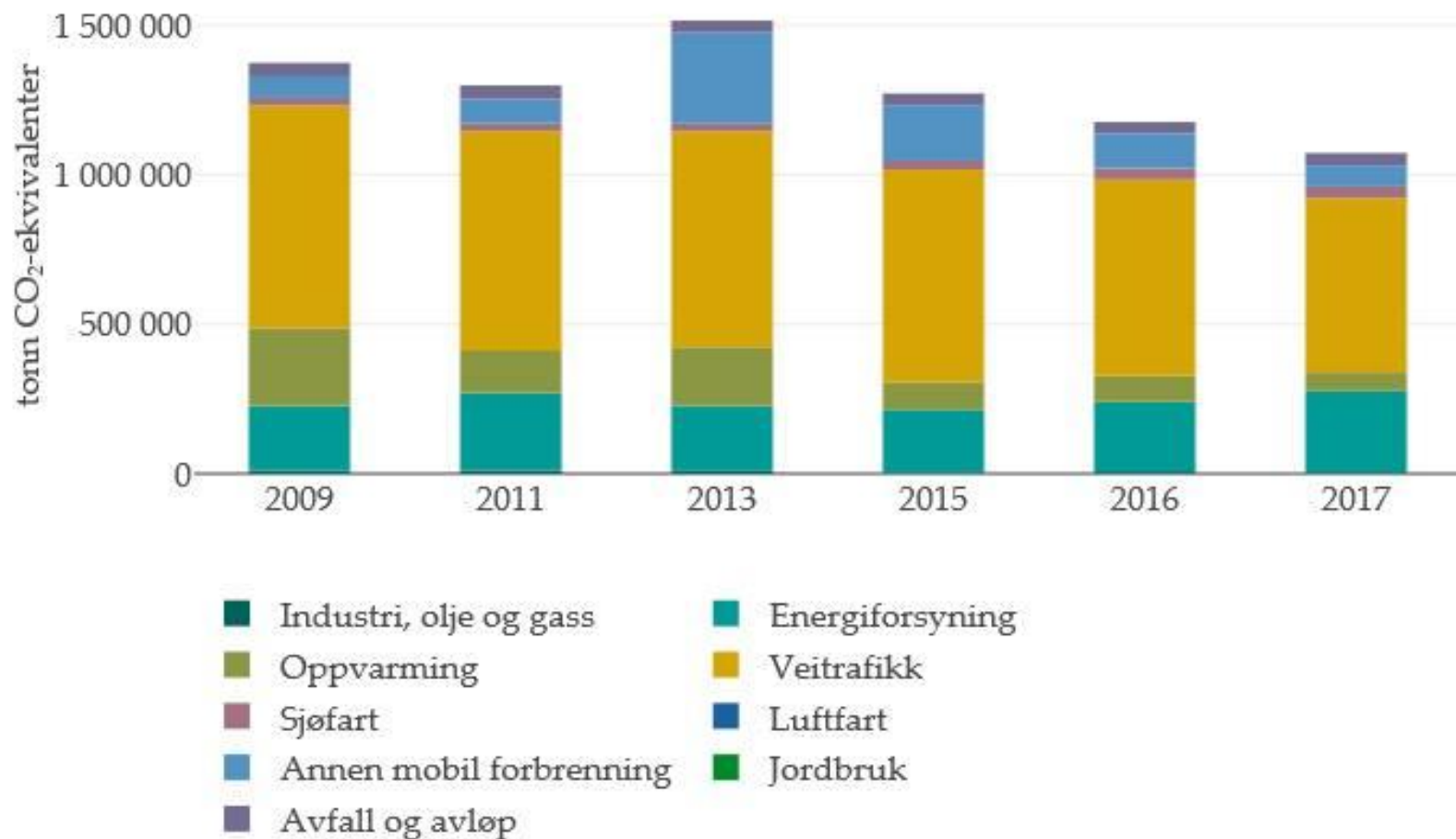

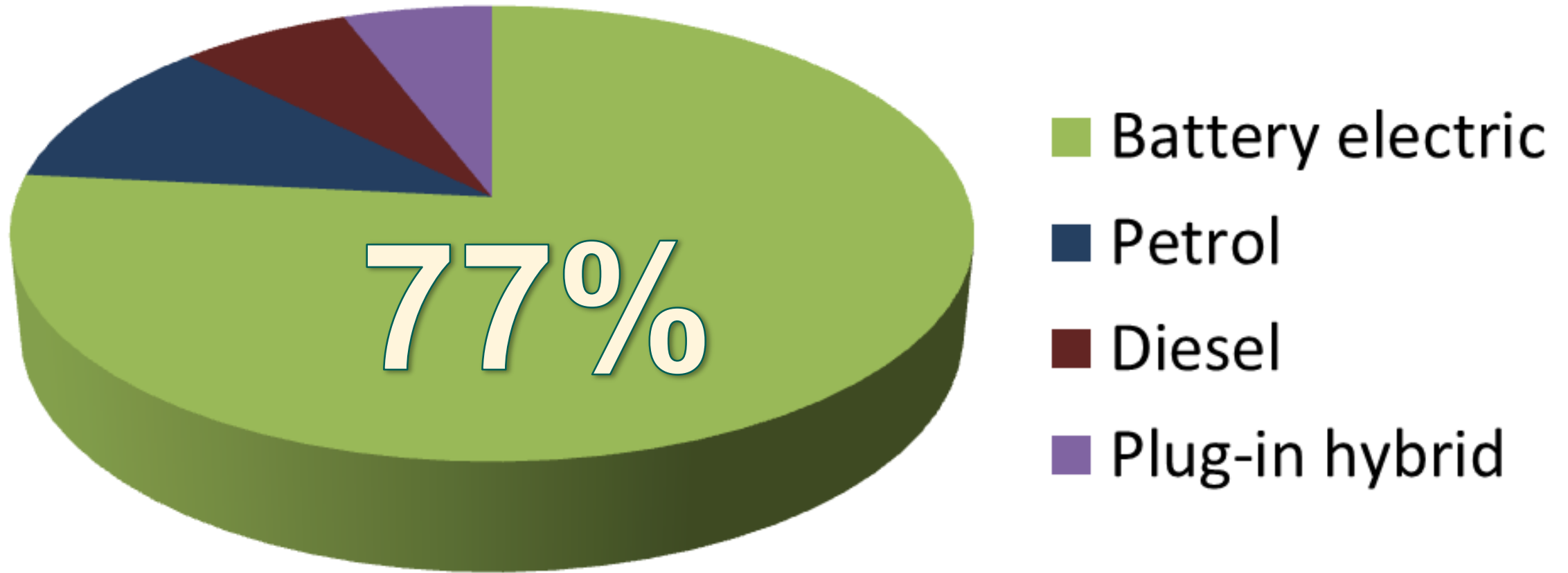


Emissions in Oslo

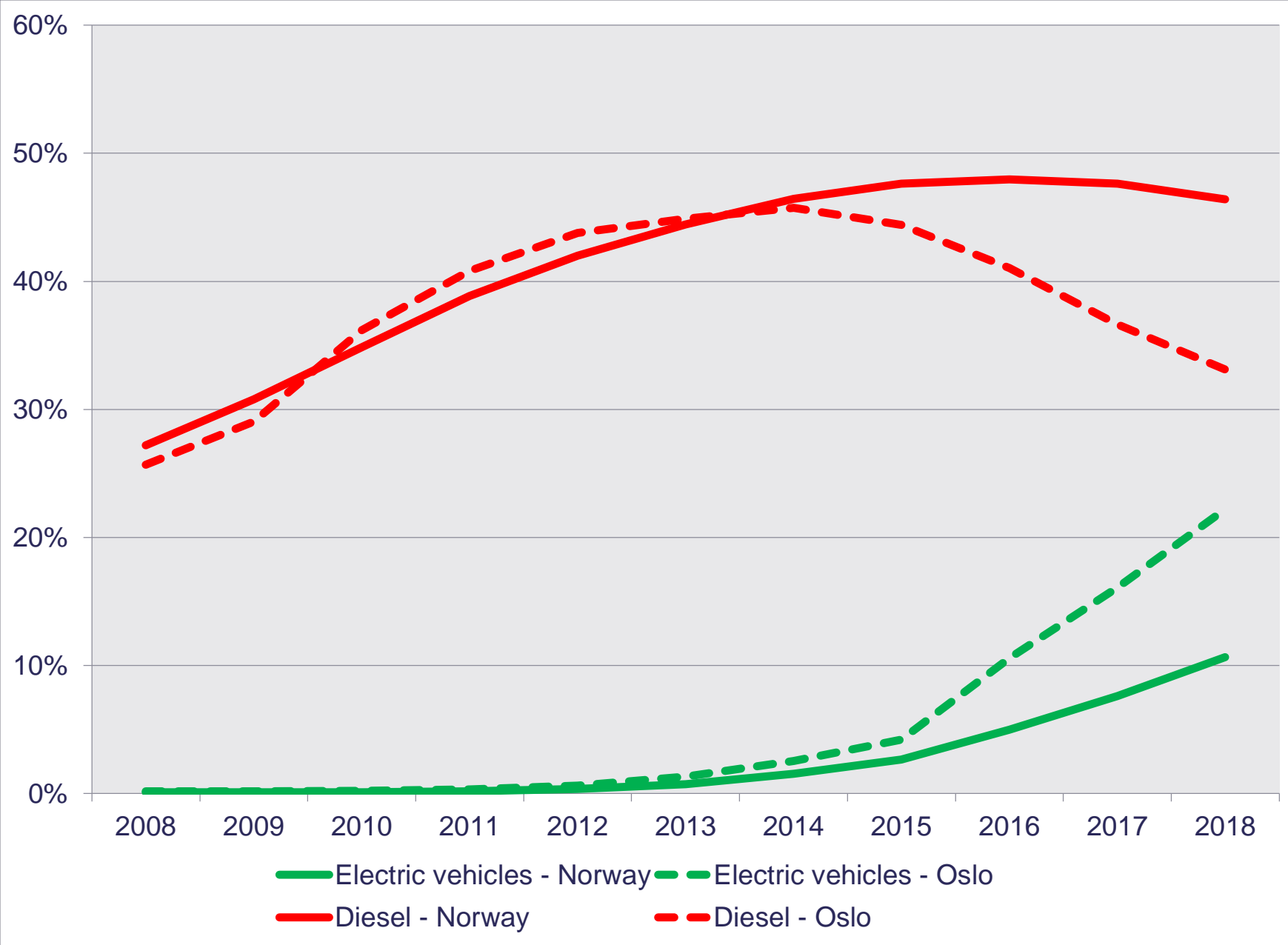

- ▶ Network of 1300 public chargers
- ▶ Ramping up with 600 new in 2019
- ▶ People want to charge at home
- ▶ Granted support to facilitate 20.000 new home chargers in 2018
- ▶ We are now preparing for electric taxis and vans

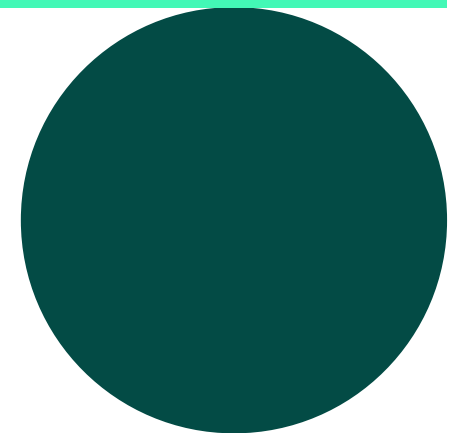

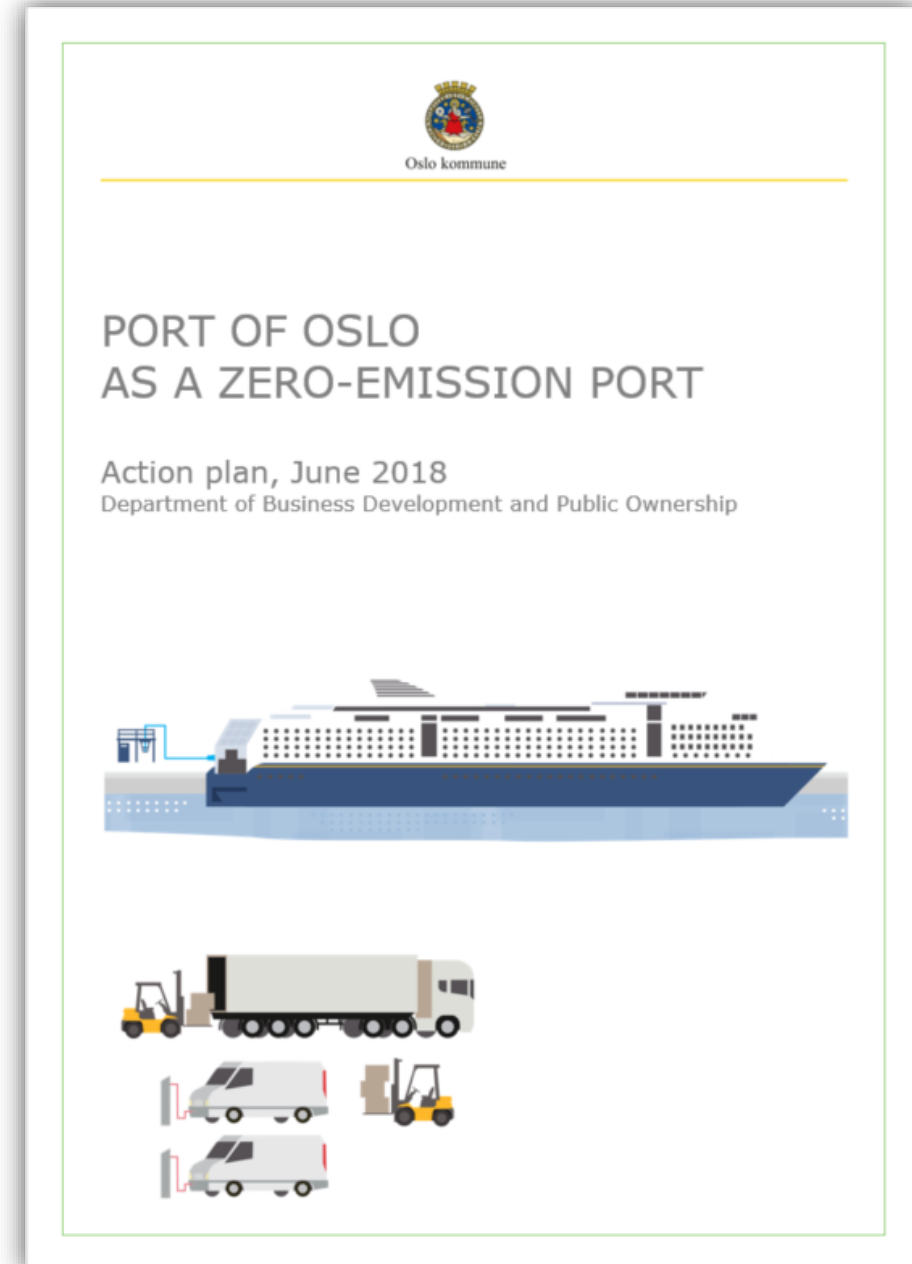


Oslo Innovation Hub



Action Plan Zero Emission Port

- ▶ Approved by the City Council November 2018
- ▶ Zero emission in 2050
- ▶ 17 measures with an ambitious timeline for implementation
- ▶ 85 % reduction of CO2 emissions by 2030
